# Dining Plan Exemption Instructions For Internships

Participating in an Internship is an important part of your college experience. Your internship will allow you to apply the knowledge and skills you have developed during your studies as an underclassman in a real world situation. This experience is a valuable asset to your resume and can provide strong references/recommendations when seeking employment after graduation.

An important part of your internship experience is actually living in the area where you will be working. Whether you stay in Alabama, or travel hundreds of miles to work for your internship; living, eating and spending time with your coworkers will allow you to ask questions and gain essential experience to use in your future career. With that in mind, Campus Dining allows interns an exemption from the required dining plan if they meet the requirements of item C on the exemption application. To exempt yourself from the dining plan, you will need to complete the required form and submit it to campus dining before the deadline.

#### Here's how to submit your application for a dining plan exemption:

- 1. Complete the DINING PLAN EXEMPTION APPLICATION (next page)
- 2. Have the completed application signed by your advisor
- 3. Print a copy of your class schedule showing your internship. Make sure this printout shows your name and student ID#.
- 3. Deliver the completed, signed form along with your class schedule to Campus Dining's office:
